This makes Mental Health the 5th most common reason for sickness/absence from the workplace in 2022.

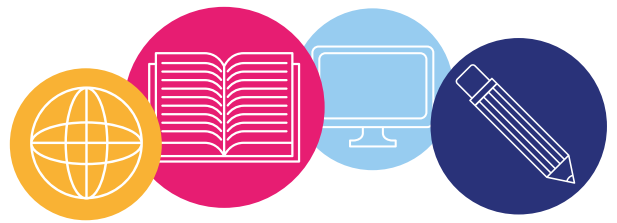
